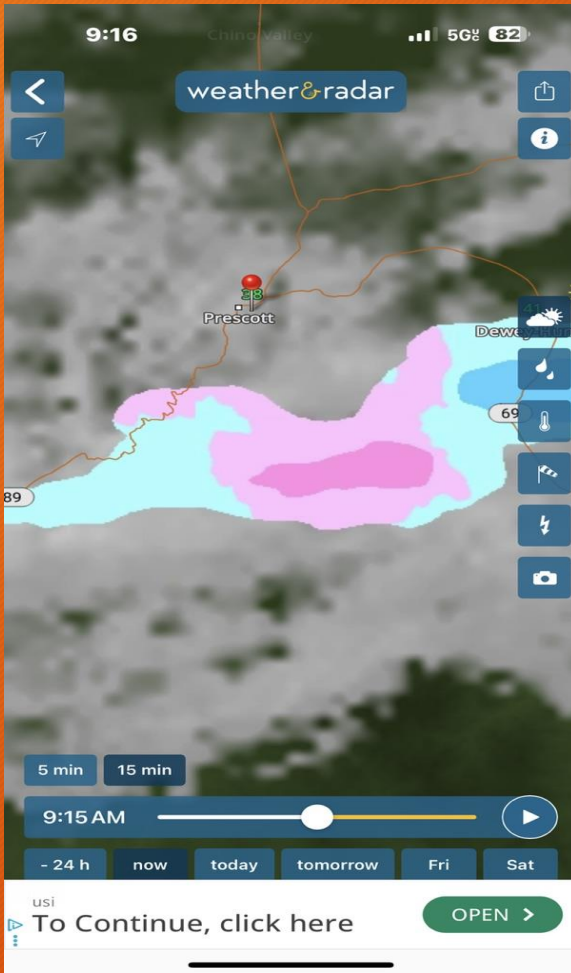
And what does he find? Cody Bennett AND...

Looks great for Hacking!

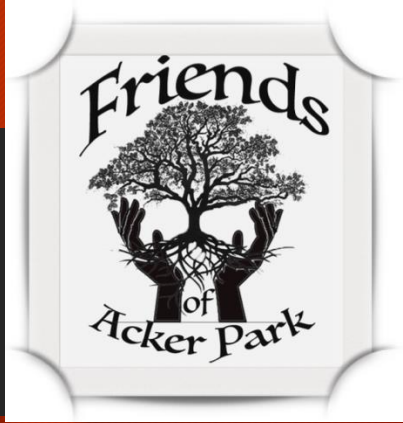
We will work Hacking for 1.25 hours, spend fifteen minutes chowing down resting. Then the last half hour we drag our debris to be removed.
