We will start up again on Wednesday, January 7nd.

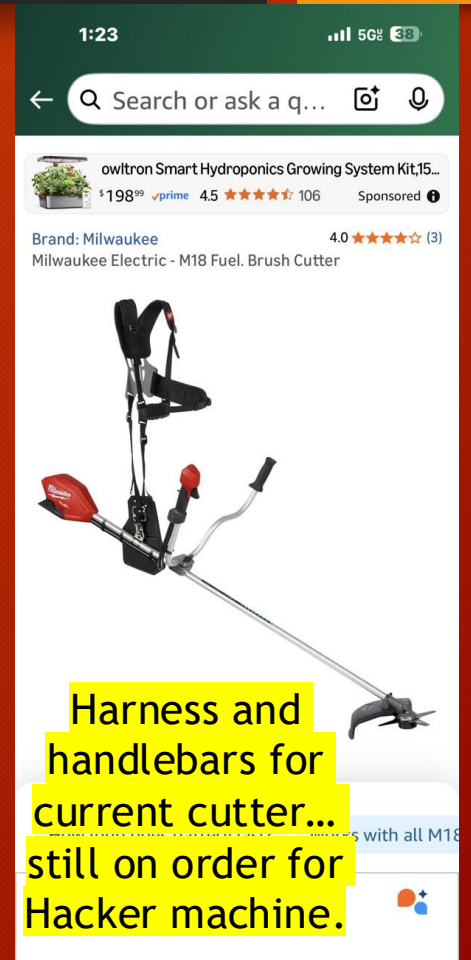
